7. 2018-2019 INNISFAIL/OLDS CALENDAR

In Innisfail and Olds there will be a change to parent teacher Interview dates in November in order to comply with the Collective Agreement and due to the fact that ATA is not open to a "Letter of Understanding" during negotiations. According to the Collective Agreement a lieu day must follow parent teacher interviews and in order to accommodate this the interviews will move to the evenings of November 7 and 8.

8. MONTHLY BUDGET INFORMATION

The Secretary-Treasurer reviewed the monthly budget. It appears the division is on pace for a \$1.7M deficit as planned.

9. PROPOSED NEW DRAFT K-4 PROVINCIAL CURRICULUM

The Associate Superintendent of Inclusive Learning provided information on the new Social Studies K to Grade 4 curriculum. Curriculum and Development Management Application (CDMA) is an online collaboration tool which will be used by all Alberta teachers and he felt this would create a lot of collaboration among teachers in the province. He feels this curriculum will also allow for good project based learning opportunities. To date no authorized texts have been approved but this information will be finalized in December.

CAPITAL PROJECTS UPDATE

St. Patrick Modernization

The demolition of eight classrooms has been completed over the summer and work has started on the foundation for the new addition. Demolition of the equipment in the mechanical room occurred and new air handling units were installed and work continues on the installation of new boilers. The main student washroom was also demolished and rebuilt over the summer break and was operational for students on their first day.

Our Lady of the Rosary Modular addition

With the delay in the delivery of the modulars from the manufacturer, we expect modulars to be ready for pickup in August 22 to be completed by the end of September.

Holy Trinity Modular addition

Work has progressed progressed on the construction of the link required for the modular classrooms. The modulars are expected to to be ready for pickup in August with completion expected by the end of September.

St. Matthew Modular addition

Work has progressed on the construction of the link required for the modular classrooms. We are hopeful the modulars will be ready for pickup in the end of August or first few weeks of September.

Fr. Henri Voisin Modular addition

ABC School has been working to provide occupancy of these three new classrooms as soon as possible. The delivery of the modulars from the manufacturer has caused this delay.

Montfort/ Cultural Services

At the completion of the Canada Winter Games, the City of the Red Deer will be vacating the Cultural Services (Old administration building). This additional space will allow Montfort Centre to evaluate departmental needs and relocate departments based on this assessment. A RFP was issued for Architectural Services to conduct this assessment and develop detailed construction drawings. After evaluation of the submissions, the team of Group2 Architects was selected for this project.

Facility Master Plan Projects

Several larger FMP projects took place over the summer including the following:

-New parking lot at Holy Trinity School.

-St. Matthew School learning commons upgrades.

-Maryview School main office and learning commons renovations.

-St. Francis of Assisi School security camera installation.
