Curriculum Coordinator Proposal

In order to streamline and make more efficient the development of Alberta curriculum and resource coordination for Catholic schools, trustees and CCSSA are being asked to consider the creation and implementation of a Curriculum Coordinator role.

The coordinator would have a theological background and pedagogical experience in Catholic schools to oversee and coordinate RE Curriculum and Resource development on behalf of Catholic school boards in Alberta. The Board broadly supports this idea. The next step is to have the ACSTA approve it.

Meeting with Minister LaGrange

The board of trustees have been invited to meet with Alberta's new Minister of Education on June 14 at 1:00 p.m. in the board room at Montfort Centre. The meeting will last one hour and trustees are encouraged to formulate ideas on what to discuss and generate a list of topics to bring forward for discussion.

Advocacy

The board of trustees plan to send a letter in conjunction with Red Deer Public Schools about the need for more funding for mental health initiatives in and around the City of Red Deer. The letter will be addressed to Alberta's new Associate Minister of Mental Health.

This date will allow students to finish the school year and complete their exams without disruptions caused by moving to a new location. Phase three will begin after this school year and is anticipated to be completed this November.
