# HIGH SCHOOL REDESIGN AND FLEXIBILITY PROJECT

Principals from Ecole Notre Dame and St. Dominic high schools indicated that they are currently half way through this pilot project and both schools are progressing and implementing focus areas that work for their specific schools and demographics. This project has allowed the schools to accommodate students in many areas and focus on several ways to ensure success for all high school students.
