Catholic Pre-Kindergarten Program





Assessment and Eligibility

Your child will participate in a specialized assessment to collect information across a variety of learning contexts to determine your child's strengths and areas of need. It will provide direction to develop an Individualized Program Plan.

You will book an assessment when completing the online application. Results will be shared with you within two to three weeks following the assessment. If your child is eligible, the registration process will proceed.

Program Fee

There are no program fees.

Classroom Schedule

Our Pre-Kindergarten Program runs from September to June. Depending on the school, our three-hour half-day program is offered in the morning or afternoon.

Family Oriented Programming sessions are offered and highly encouraged for families to participate on select non-programmed days and evenings.

Transportation

- It draws on the knowledge and expertise of parents and engages them in decision making through meetings and family oriented sessions
- It is taught by certified teachers supported by educational assistants, registered speechlanguage pathologists and other professionals
- It is delivered in a small classroom setting allowing the learning team to address the unique needs of each child
- It focuses on playful learning where children interact, explore, and make sense of the world around them

Registration

Your child must be 4 years of age by December 31 of the upcoming school year.
