#### 2014-2015 Audited Financial Statements

Representatives from the auditing firm of MNP were in attendance to provide the Board with an overview of the 2014-2015 Audited Financial Statements. It has been confirmed that these statements were filed in accordance with Canadian audit standards with no incidences of fraud or non-compliance.

# **Fine Arts Pilot Project**

This Comprehensive Music Program is designed to expose elementary students to all areas of music, including singing, listening, moving, reading, writing, creating music and playing all types of instruments. This multi-faceted program gives students the opportunity to choose what areas of music they would like to explore. The overall goal of the program is to create a greater enjoyment and appreciation of music.



## **Syrian Refugee Families**

The City of Red Deer awaits the arrival of 200-250 refugees from Syria. Our Division will use a translator to help inform these new Canadians about education in Alberta as well as the differences between the public and Catholic school systems. Our Division is most concerned about the social, mental and emotional wellbeing of these refugees and will welcome students into our schools with open arms. We have a strong ESL Program and Counsellors on hand to help assist these students and their families with integrating into their new country.
