4. 2016-2017 STUDENT ENROLLMENT

The Secretary-Treasurer updated Trustees with regards to the 2016-2017 student enrollment data. The Division has 9,541 students to date which is a 4.44% increase from last year's enrolment.

5. CATHOLIC EDUCATION SUNDAY - NOVEMBER 6, 2016

Catholic Education Sunday is on November 6th and one Trustee will speak at each Mass within the Divisions' parishes that weekend. A schedule was generated for Trustees to attend local Masses.

6. TRUSTEE REMUNERATION AS PER POLICY 19

The Secretary-Treasurer brought forward a recommendation relative to Trustee remuneration for 2016-2017. He presented an average of the provincial Trustee remuneration guide sent

out by the Alberta School Boards Association (ASBA) which indicated that the Division's Trustees fall 40 - 49% below provincial average. He recommended that Trustees increase their salary substantially in order to move closer to provincial average and do not continue to fall behind their colleagues in the province. After discussion, Trustees felt that such an increase was difficult but that continually falling behind is not beneficial for upcoming boards. It was also noted that a large increase in this economy could not be justified and Trustees agreed to a minimal increase of \$5.00 per day to the per diem rate and a current (August 31) Alberta Cost of Living increase to the per annum rate.

- St. Marguerite Bourgeoys School
