4. OPTING OUT OF ALBERTA SCHOOL FOUNDATION FUND

The Alberta School Trustees' Association has encouraged its member Boards to exercise their right to opt out of the Alberta School Foundation Fund (ASFF) per s.164(2) through (5) of the Education Act.

RECOMMENDATION: THAT THE BOARD OPT OUT OF THE ALBERTA SCHOOL FOUNDATION FUND (ASFF) PER S.164(2) THROUGH (5) OF THE EDUCATION ACT, UPON PASSING.

5. TENDER REVIEW PROCESS

Alberta Infrastructure requires a board motion giving delegated authority for an individual to act on behalf of the board. This is required in order to streamline the approval requirements in order to move projects forward in a timely manner while still following the School Buildings and Tendering Regulation. This motion will be cited each time the Division requests contract approval. The last motion with regards to this was on November 15, 2015.

RECOMMENDATION: THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES APPROVES THE SUPERINTENDENT TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE BOARD FOR THE TENDER REVIEW PROCESS UNDER \$1.5M AND THE BOARD BE NOTIFIED OF SUCH TENDERS.
