Alberta Education provides an opportunity for School Divisions to review their Three Year Capital Plan submission mid-year to make any necessary adjustments. Administration recommends that the new K-5 school in Blackfalds be moved to priority 2 of the Three Year Plan. A new K-5 elementary and a new K-5 Fl elementary in Red Deer would then move to priority 3 and 4 respectfully. A revised plan has been included for Trustees to review with the updated September 30, 2018 student enrolment numbers.

6. 2018-2019 STUDENT ENROLLMENT (E)

8. PAT/DIPLOMA RESULTS (E)

The Associate Superintendent of Inclusive Learning will provide a synopsis of the 2018 PAT and diploma examination results.

9. MELT (MANDATORY ENTRY LEVEL TRAINING) (E)

On October 10, 2018 the Honourable Brian Mason, Minister of Transportation, announced that Alberta is mandating training for new commercial drivers and strengthening safety requirements for commercial carriers to enhance public safety. Effective March 1, 2019, any person who wants to obtain a Class 1 (truck driver) or Class 2 (school bus driver) driver's licence must take the Mandatory Entry Level Training (MELT) Program. The MELT program is a standardized curriculum that consists of in-classroom, in-vehicle (in-yard where the vehicle is not moving) and on-road training. Administration has had an opportunity to review the impact to the Division.

St. Patrick Modernization

Structural steel is complete. Roofing has started on the building and the floor was scheduled to be placed on October 24. Work is progressing on schedule and under budget.

Our Lady of the Rosary Modular addition

The modulars are ready for occupancy but we are still having issues with controlling the furnaces in these rooms.

Holy Trinity Modular addition

We expect to have these ready for occupancy by the end of October.

St. Matthew Modular addition

Work is continuing on these units with occupancy expected in late November.

The modulars are now occupied.
