### 6. 2019 SCHOOL DIVISION ACOL RESULTS

The Associate Superintendent of Inclusive Learning provided Trustees with a synopsis of the 2018-2019 accountability pillar overall summary. It is noteworthy that our school division scored higher than the provincial average on 13 of the 16 measures. Further, as a school division there has been improvement in PAT acceptable results as well as movement forward in PAT excellence outcomes which is the result of administration, teachers and students all contributing toward this success. Dr. Khatib added that there is much to celebrate throughout the division as we continue our quest to improve in all areas specifically with regard to improving Diploma acceptable and excellence results.

### 7. 2018-2019 STUDENT ENROLMENT

The Secretary-Treasurer informed trustees that the official student enrolment numbers as of October 1, 2019 are 10,483 which amounts to a growth of 1.7%.

### 8. CURRICULUM COORDINATOR PROPOSAL

In order to streamline and make more efficient the development of Alberta curriculum and resource coordination for Catholic schools, trustees and CCSSA are being asked to consider the creation and implementation of a Curriculum Coordinator role. Trustees supported the recommendation from CCSSA and ACSTA for a .50 position.

## 9. MONTHLY BUDGET INFORMATION

The Secretary-Treasurer estimated a \$418,000 deficit from the spring budget, however, this has changed with the new provincial budget that came out on October 24. Final numbers will be brought to the November board meeting with an estimated \$2M deficit.

## 10. CATHOLIC EDUCATION SUNDAY - NOVEMBER 3, 2019

Trustees signed up to speak at all masses for the upcoming weekend to promote Catholic Education Sunday.

### 11. MEETING WITH CITY OF RED DEER MAYOR AND COUNCIL

Trustees will be meeting with the City of Red Deer on November 13. Agenda items to be submitted are:

- 1. Need for serviced land for a middle school site.
- 2. Transit changes.

## 12. 2019 EDUCATION BUDGET UPDATE

With the release of the October 24 provincial budget, the Secretary-Treasurer reported a loss of three major funding sources to education which include Class Improvement Funding, School Fees Funding and Class Size Initiative Funding. This amounts to a loss of approximately \$2.5M in revenue for the division. RDCRS is also negatively impacted by the transition funding provided as urban school boards will receive \$203 per student while rural school divisions will receive \$356 per student. More accurate numbers will be available at the November board meeting.

### 13. KEY TOPICS FOR COMMUNICATION

- 1. Need for more schools within our division as almost all of our schools within the region are currently over capacity.
- 2. Budget concerns with the recent budget and the \$2M shortfall.
- 3. ACOL results.
