Innisfail, AB St. Marguerite Bourgeoys Catholic School Grade 3 and 4 students honoured Canadian veterans, by participating in a “No Stone Left Alone” this past Tuesday, October 27 at the Innisfail Cemetery by putting poppies on gravestones.

“It's important for students to take part in this because it provides them a tangible connection to those who served and sacrificed for our freedom. It is vital for them to see that members of their own community were involved in wars and battles. Participating in ‘No Stone Left Alone’ connects directly to the curriculum.
