The Superintendent presented to the Board of Trustees the Division's plans for Catholic Education Sunday.

Superintendent Report:

First Annual Red Deer International Powwow

The Superintendent commended the Division's Indigenous Education Services team for their fantastic work with the First Annual Red Deer International Powwow. The diverse Indigenous nations gathered for their cultural ceremony of the powwow; this created an opportunity to connect people with culture, dance, art and music. The event was a great success, with RDCRS having a prominent presence as donors, volunteers and participants.

Alberta Education Kindergarten-Grade 6 Curriculum Review

The Associate Superintendent of Curriculum shared with the Board of Trustees that RDCRS has collaborated with the College of Alberta School Superintendents (CASS) to provide system leader input for their project. Teachers have been invited to participate in subject-area, virtual "Think Tanks," with the first one taking place on October 25. An RDCRS Connects parent survey has also been developed and will be released for parent input on Monday, November 1.

All of the feedback from the initial stakeholder engagement survey that captured the voices of teachers through virtual feedback sessions, in addition to the teacher curriculum "Think Tanks" and the upcoming RDCRS Connects parent survey, will be synthesized into a final report of the draft curriculum. Kindergarten Catchment 2022-2023

The Superintendent presented the Board of Trustees the Kindergarten catchment plans for the 2022-2023 school year, in which Kindergarten students will go to their catchment school rather than waiting until Grade 1 to attend their designated school. In doing so, this will help to ensure growth in all communities as well as secure school programming.

The Division's Early Learning Team will inform current Pre-Kindergarten families of their catchment school for the 2022-2023 school year, and current Kindergarten students will be informed of their catchment area for Grade 1 during the November Parent Teacher Interviews.
