The Edwin Parr Teacher Award was established in 1964 and named in honour of Edwin Parr, former president of the Alberta School Trustees' Association (now ASBA). It honours six outstanding first-year Kindergarten to Grade 12 teachers who have taught in a ASBA member school board.

St. Patrick's Community School Principal Mandy Reed said McCulloch's passion for teaching and commitment to student success have set her apart since she joined the school community in August 2023.
